


The program encourages students and teachers to have courageous conversations around the following United Nations Global Goals for Sustainable Development (Global Goals).




## HOW DOES IT WORK?

This is an integrated program which engages primary school students in sustainability awareness, understanding and action through art, design, creativity, teamwork and project development by:

- Providing a blank fibreglass koala for students to create an artwork on or to use as the subject of an artwork which focuses on a global goal.
- Pairing schools with a Community Champion, who holds the knowledge, wisdom and experience to assist the students to learn about local projects which are already addressing Australia's Global Goals commitment.
- Supporting and empowering young people to co-create a project that they design, own and deliver either in-school or out in the community with their intergenerational mentors.
- Providing a vehicle for students to communicate what they learn in fun and creative ways to a broader online audience and their local community.
- Supplying a resource kit with curricular connections.
- Supplying Matisse paints..

## THE CHALLENGE?

Participating in the Kreative Koalas competition involves completing two exciting modules.

#### **1. THE KOALA**

Use the blank fibreglass Koala and the Global Goal you have chosen to create an artwork.

#### 2. COMMUNITY PROJECT

Working with your Community Champion/Sustainability Ambassador and using the Sustainability Action Process (SAP)<sup>2</sup> to support students to identify, investigate and take sustainability action, the students will co-design a local community project. The Sustainability Action Process has five steps:

- 1. Making a case for change
- 2. Developing the scope
- 3. Defining the proposal
- 4. Implementing
- 5. Evaluating and reflecting

Your project offers your students the chance to turn great ideas into practical solutions. The project can be in-school or out in the community.

Students will be empowered to decide what they want to do and what impact they want to have.

Please note to successfully complete the program, modules 1 and 2 must be submitted.

# WHAT'S INVOLVED IN THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS

- Fill in the online expression of interest form on behalf of your school by COB 11th March 2022. The link to the EOI can be found <u>HERE</u>.
- Students participating in the program complete an online entry survey by 7th April 2022. The online entry survey details will be supplied once you have submitted your EOI.
- Successful schools will be notified by 27th April 2022.
- The Kreative Koalas program will commence Monday 2nd may 2022.
- Selection of SDG/s to focus your artwork and project on.

## BEFORE YOU COMPLETE THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FORM

Please ensure you consider the following:

- A visit from a Community Champion/Sustainability Ambassador who will present to your students, support your sustainability learning journey through regular touch points, and help you to cocreate a community project.
- The opportunity to be named **Grand Champion Kreative Koala**.
- 2. Your expression of interest form is a contract between the program organiser and your school.
  - Your Koala artwork, Digital Learning Journey and Community Action Project Report must be completed by 19th September 2022.
  - Do you have other teachers in your school as enthusiastic about participating in the program as you?

- Is your student team and collaborating teacher/s 100% committed to delivering on all program commitments?

- Are you going on long service leave in any part of the program time frame? And if so, will you put in place measures to help the program continue in your absence?

## THE KREATIVE KOALAS PROGRAM CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This is a game of skill. All entries will be reviewed by an expert panel of judges appointed by project organisers.
- 2. Competition commences on the launch date. Only one entry per primary school.
- To enter schools must complete the Expression of Interest Form supplied and must be received 11th March 2022.
- Paint supplies will be supplied by commercial art supply company Matisse Derivan<sup>™</sup>.
- 5. The Koala remains the property of the school, except in the case where all elements of the program are not completed by the school for any reason.
- 6. Project organisers reserve the right to invite schools to provide the Koalas for promotional activities or public display without payment of any fee.
- The winning entries will be announced at the exhibition and presentation day In November 2022 Date TBC.
- 8. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 9. The Project Organiser collects entrants' personal information in order to conduct the promotion. By entering the promotion, unless otherwise advised, each entrant also agrees that the Project Organiser may use this information, in any media for future promotional, marketing and publicity purposes without any further reference, payment or other compensation to the entrant, including sending the entrant electronic messages. A request to access, update or correct any information should be directed to the Project Organiser at their address set out below.
